



Avnet was formed in 1921 when the US government lifted its ban on private radio, prompting Charles Avnet, a 33 year-old immigrant from Russia, to begin buying and selling radio parts in Manhattan. It kicked off a century of firsts for Avnet and started a history that we've maintained ever since. The first distributor to place an order for Intel's microprocessor in 1971, Avnet soon was operating microprocessor demonstration centers and then in the 1980s started distributing board level development systems along with complementary software, printers and PCs.

In 1984 we built our first mega-warehouse in Peabody, Massachusetts, centralizing and automating distribution for the first time and facilitating faster quotes better processing, inventory management and being able to add more economical services, changing the distribution of technology for ever.

Phil Gallagher, Avnet's CEO noted `In 100 years, Avnet has gone from a small component shop to a global distributor firmly set at the centre of the technology value chain.'
